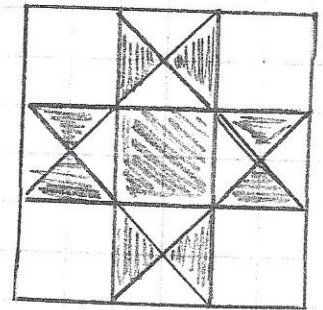


August- Ohio Star with Sunflower 6" Finished



Fabric Required:

Ohio Star- Light- fat quarter for background
 Dark fat quarter for star points & center square-
 Sunflower Appliqué- scraps of green gold & brown

Cutting: If using 2.0 Thangles
 (YES!!_you can make quarter
 square triangles with Thangles)

Light (4) 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

(1) 2 1/2" X 22"

Dark (1) 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

(1) 2 1/2" X 22"

OR

for Traditional Template Free
 Piecing

Light (4) 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

(2) 3 1/4" X 3 1/4"

Dark (1) 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

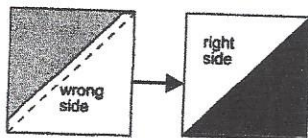

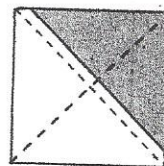
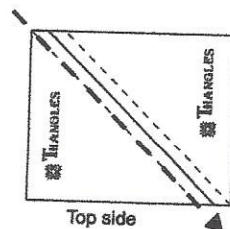
Using Thangles— Step # 1: Use the 2 1/2" X 22" light & dark , and
 following manufacturer's directions, make (8) light/dark half square
 triangles. Follow these directions and make (4) quarter square
 triangles:

2. Put the half square triangles
 with the dark fabric facing the light
 and right sides together.

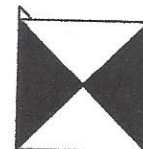
The seams will line up perfectly.



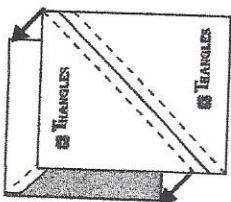
4. Stitch on the dotted line that
 is lined up with the corners.



5. Cut on the solid line, flip the
 unit over and open it up. Press
 with the paper on. Trim the one
 end and take away the paper.



3. Put aTHANGLES template
 on top of this sandwich as
 shown. Line up one of the
 dotted stitching lines with
 opposing corners.



The
 THANGLES
 template is
 slightly
 longer
 than
 your
 squares.

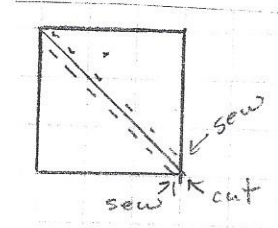

Traditional Template Free Piecing

Pair the light and dark $3\frac{1}{4}$ " X $3\frac{1}{4}$ " squares , right sides together.

On the wrong side of the light, draw a diagonal line corner to corner.

Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line.

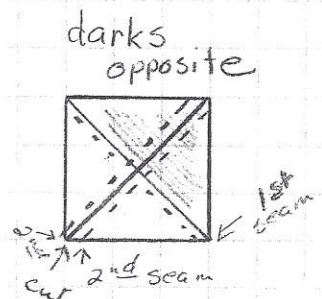


Cut apart on the drawn line, press with the seams toward the dark. This will make (4) light/dark half square triangles.

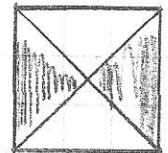
Pair the light/dark half square triangles right sides together with the darks on opposite sides and the seams lined up perfectly.

Draw a diagonal line corner to corner, so that it makes an X with the sewn seam.

Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line, press open.



This will make (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " light/dark quarter square triangles.

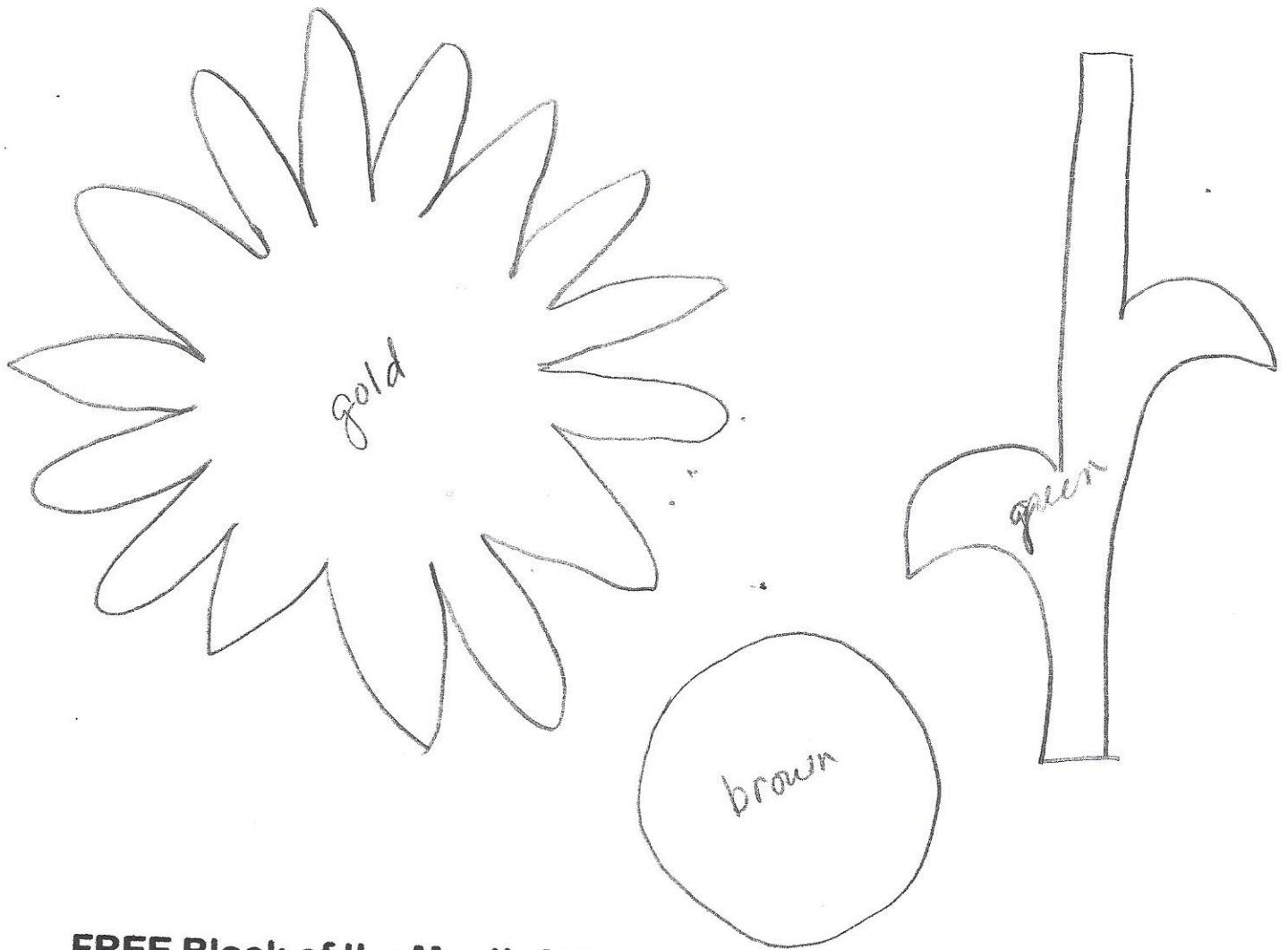


Piece the Ohio Star as an equal 9-patch as in the illustration at the beginning of these instructions.

The (4) light $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $2\frac{1}{2}$ " are the four corners, and the dark $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X $2\frac{1}{2}$ " is the center.

Sunflower appliqué: follow general appliqué instructions:

Note: The gold petals of the sunflower are cut as one piece, I stitched into the center on each petal to make it appear as they are separate.
