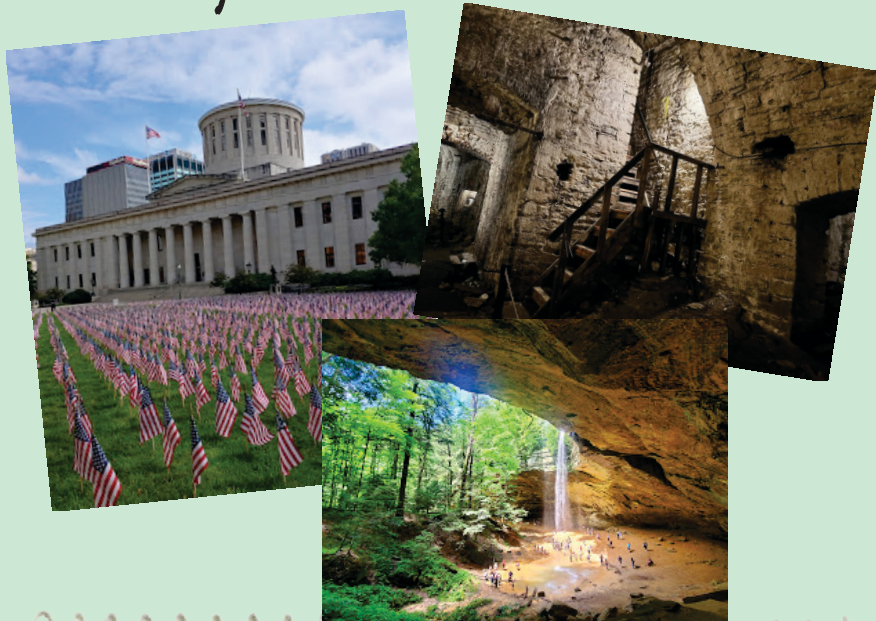

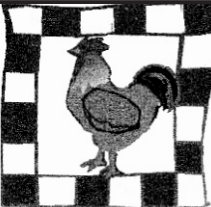

Easy Corn Salad
6 ears corn
olive oil, for brushing
3 Roma tomatoes, diced
3 green onions, sliced
1 red bell pepper, diced
1 jalapeno, sliced thinly
3 T. olive oil
juice of 3 limes
salt and black pepper
3/4 c. fresh cilantro leaves, roughly
chopped

Prepare a grill for med-high heat. Brush the corn with olive oil and sprinkle with salt and pepper. Grill until cooked and browned, about 10 min. Set aside to cool.

Put the tomatoes, onions, pepper and jalapeno in a salad bowl. Pour over the olive oil and lime juice, sprinkle with a pinch salt and pepper and toss.

Cut the corn off the cobs then toss gently with the salad. Sprinkle over the cilantro leaves and gently mix in.

Country Register Recipe

Springtime Apple Salad

2 cups mixed greens (spinach, arugula, or lettuce)

1 apple, thinly sliced (red or green)

1/2 c. grapes, halved

1/2 c. dried cranberries

1/2 c. walnuts or pecans, chopped

1/4 c. feta cheese, crumbled

1/4 c. cucumber, sliced

Dressing:

3 T. olive oil

1 T. apple cider vinegar

1 tsp. honey

1/2 tsp. Dijon mustard

1/2 tsp. salt

1/4 tsp. black pepper

In a large salad bowl, add mixed greens. Top with sliced apples, grapes, cranberries, nuts, cheese, and cucumber.

In a small bowl, whisk together olive oil, apple cider vinegar, honey, Dijon mustard, salt, and black pepper. Drizzle dressing over the salad and toss gently to combine.

Serve immediately for the freshest taste.

Tips: Use crisp apples like Fuji or Honey Crisp, toast nuts for extra flavor and crunch, add grilled chicken for a protein boost

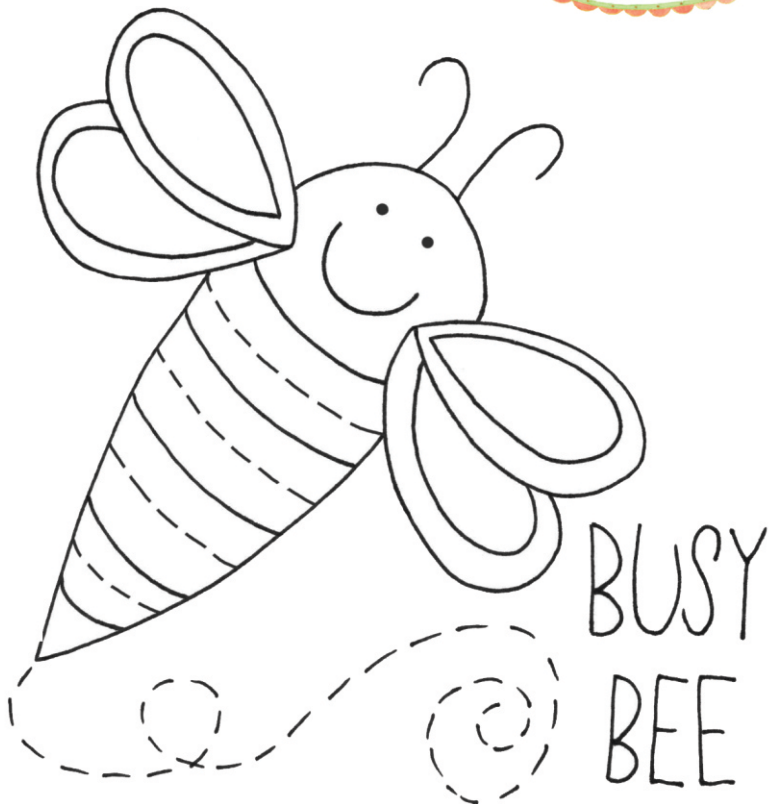

Woven beeskeps are a signature country motif that can be put on a large, seasoned stump or tall post as a focal point to enjoy. Country accents like tall, colorful birdhouses can be hung against the backdrop of a primitive fence to add color amongst the growing herbs. A sundial can be mounted on a hand-hewn post to become a central image in the kitchen clipping garden.

When it comes time to harvest our first batches of tender herbs, there is nothing like bringing out our sturdy, splint gathering baskets to assist in this joyful country task. As we gather, bind, and hang our first bundles of sage, sweet marjoram, and lemon balm, we are easily inspired, for this is only the beginning. Our gardens, whether culinary, medicinal, or decorative will serve us well with our generous care. And in exchange for our efforts our reward will be a feeling of true peace that comes with deep connection.

Honoring True Beauty - This season take time to savor the simple yet significant gifts of spring. Delight in being surrounded by true moments of beauty—like the unexpected return of your first hummingbird, or the vibrant first blooms of the lilac bush that graced your front step stone for generations. Take comfort in knowing that these reminders will always be around us if we take the time to honor them.

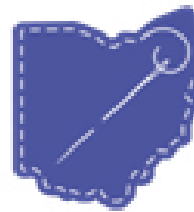

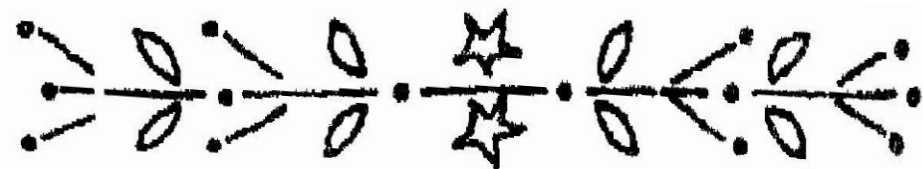



Chicken Caprese Flatbread

- 2 pieces flatbread
- 2 T olive oil
- 2 c. chicken, shredded or chopped, can use rotisserie
- 8 oz. fresh mozzarella
- 1 c. ripe tomatoes
- 1/4 c. basil pesto
- 1/2 tsp. garlic powder
- 2 T. balsamic glaze
- 1/4 c. fresh basil

Preheat oven to 400°F, with a pizza stone or baking sheet inside.

Brush flatbread generously with olive oil, and sprinkle with garlic powder if desired. Spread basil pesto evenly on the flatbread, then layer with chicken, mozzarella, and tomatoes. Drizzle with olive oil.

Bake the flatbread for about 10-15 min. until the cheese is melted and bubbly.

Remove from the oven, garnish with fresh basil and balsamic glaze, slice, and serve hot.

Pecan Pie Crescent Rolls

- 1 can crescent rolls
- 3/4 c. chopped pecans
- 1/2 c. granulated sugar
- 1/2 c. light corn syrup
- 2 T. butter, melted
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1 large egg

Preheat oven 350° Line a baking sheet with parchment paper and set aside.

In a large bowl, combine sugar, corn syrup, butter, vanilla and egg. Reserve 2 T. of this mixture for later use. Stir the pecans into the mixture until evenly coated.

Unroll the crescent rolls and place individual triangles on the baking sheet. Spoon 2-3 T. of the pecan filling onto the widest part of each triangle. Roll up towards the narrow end. Bake rolls in preheated oven for 8 min. or until they begin to set. Remove from oven and brush each with some of the reserved sugar mixture. Return to oven and bake an additional 5 min. or until lightly browned. Remove from oven.
