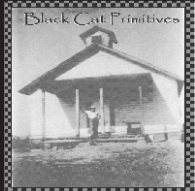

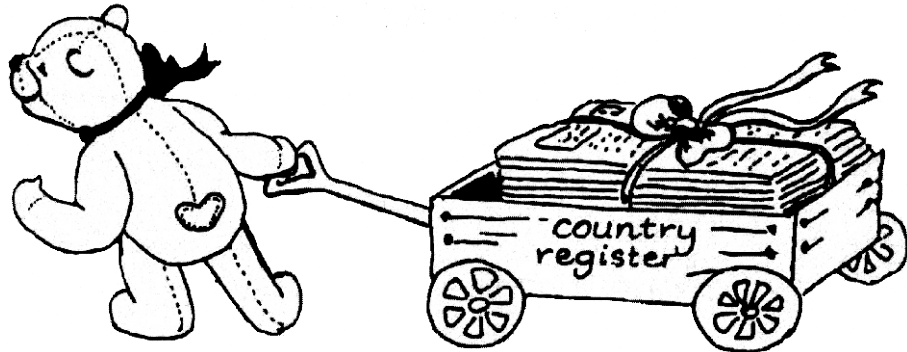

Country Register Recipe

White Lasagna Soup

- 1/4 c. olive oil
- 16 oz. sliced mushrooms
- 1 t. dried thyme
- 1 tsp. salt
- 2 tsp. Italian seasoning
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 1/4 c. flour
- 6 c. chicken broth
- 1 c. heavy cream
- 8 oz. lasagna noodles, cooked
- 4 c. fresh baby spinach (may use frozen but squeeze out the moisture)
- Ricotta cheese and pesto for garnishes

Heat oil in a Dutch oven over med-high heat. Add mushrooms, thyme and salt. Cook until the liquid is released and the mushrooms are browned, 6-8 min.

Add the Italian seasoning and minced garlic, stir and cook for 1 min. Sprinkle in the flour, stir until the all the mushrooms are coated with flour. Stir in the broth. Bring to a simmer; stir occasionally, until the mixture thickens, about 10 min.

Add the heavy cream and return to a simmer. Cut the cooked lasagna into 2" pieces and add. Then add the spinach and cook just until the spinach wilts, about 1 min. Turn off heat.

Ladle into bowls, top with ricotta cheese and a little pesto for garnish, if desired.

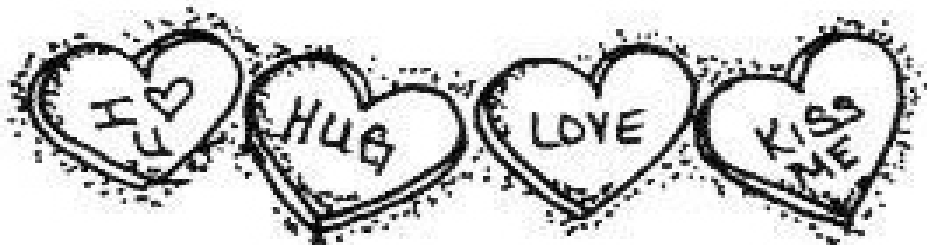

Cheesy Mashed Potato Puffs

3 c. cold mashed potatoes
(may use leftovers)

1 egg, beaten

1 c. cheddar cheese

1 T. chopped chives

1 tsp. garlic powder

2 T. flour

salt & pepper to taste

Mix mashed potatoes with egg, cheddar cheese, chives, flour, garlic powder, salt and pepper. Shape into 1" balls. Roll each ball in Parmesan cheese until lightly coated. Place on baking sheet.

Bake at 400 for 15-20 min.

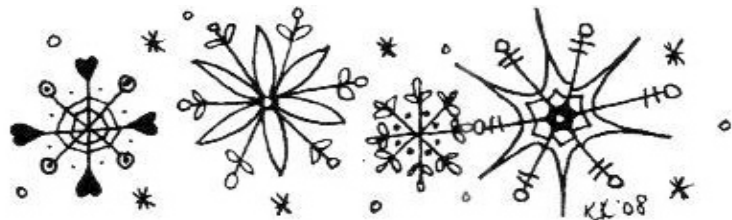

Country Register Recipe

Sheet Pan Breakfast

3 c. pancake mix + ingredients as instructed on package

1# breakfast sausage

1 c. cheddar cheese, shredded

1/4 c. syrup

Butter

Fresh fruit or fruit compote, optional

Brown 1# breakfast sausage, drain and set aside.

Prepare pancake mix following the directions on package. Add browned sausage, shredded cheddar cheese, and syrup. Stir together well.

Spray a sheet pan with cooking spray. Pour the batter onto sheet pan and spread out evenly.

Bake at 400° for about 12-15 min.

Top pancakes with butter and syrup or fruit. Enjoy!

I lived with my grandparents for three years as a little girl and then for another ten years right next door to them. Their home was a haven of comfort and peace and joy to me. Every day was a holiday with my grandmother. Our supper table always looked like a lay-out from a vintage women's magazine – deliciousness and simple beauty were always on the menu. And when any holiday rolled around, my grandmother went full tilt into making it special in every way. As for my grandfather, he was a bright beacon of warm light who loved me – not for what I did or didn't do – but simply because I was his Julie.

So, you see, in my mind, Frosty is a symbol of all the love and joy I received in my grandparents' home. But as I set Frosty upright again, I knew it was time to say goodbye. I went in and tearfully told my husband that Frosty could go with three stipulations: that he would take one last photo of me with my snowman, that he would dispose of the remains without telling me how or when or where he did it and that he would remove Frosty's little metal shovel and save it for me as a keepsake.

As I contemplated my decision further, I realized that just because Frosty goes, doesn't mean that the memories he represents have to go. I still hold all the dearness and love of my grandparents in my heart that I can access at any time. And so, though Frosty won't be back again someday, he, and all that he stands for, will forever hold a warm place in my heart.

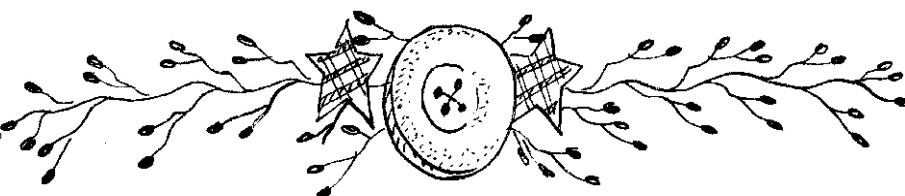

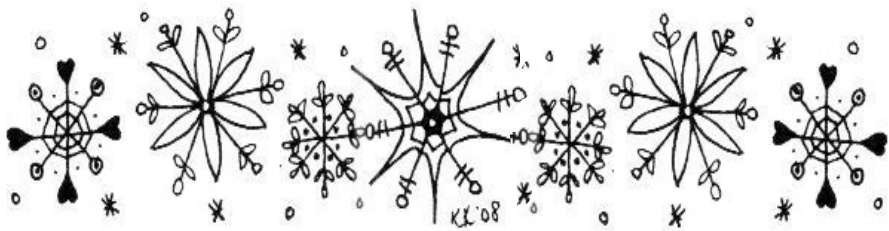

Recipe

Crispy Parmesan Chicken

- 4 8 oz. boneless skinless chicken breasts
- 1 c. flour
- 1 tsp. each paprika, salt and pepper
- 1 c. buttermilk
- 1 large egg
- 2 c. panko bread crumbs
- 1-1/2 c. finely grated Parmesan cheese
- 1-1/2 T. dried parsley flakes
- 1-1/2 tsp. garlic powder
- 1-2 tsp. onion powder
- 1/2 c. butter, melted
- Marinara or pasta sauce for serving

Preheat oven to 425°. Line two baking sheets with aluminum foil. Spray each sheet liberally with cooking spray then set aside.

Set Up Dredging Station: In a shallow bowl whisk together flour, salt, black pepper and paprika. In a second bowl whisk together buttermilk and egg. In a third bowl whisk together panko, Parmesan cheese, parsley, garlic powder and onion powder.

Use the smooth side of a meat mallet to pound the thicker portion of the chicken breast for even thickness. Dip each chicken breast into the [1] Seasoned flour mixture [2] Buttermilk egg wash [3] Panko bread crumb coating. Press the crumbs onto the chicken pieces.

Place onto the baking sheet 2" apart and drizzle each piece with melted butter.

Bake chicken breasts for 28-30 min. Turn halfway through baking. You can broil at the end of baking to brown further, if desired.

Allow the chicken to rest on the pan for a 3-5 min. before serving with warm marinara sauce or pasta sauce drizzled on top.

Broccoli Salad

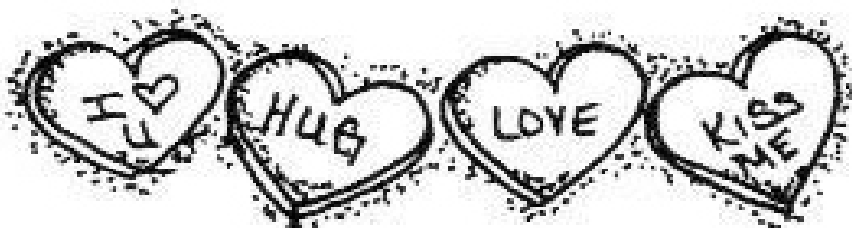
- Two 10-12 oz bags steamable broccoli florets
- 4 to 6 sprigs fresh thyme
- 1 clove garlic, grated
- Zest of 1 lemon
- 1/2 c. mayonnaise
- 1 T. plus 1 tsp. Sriracha
- 1 T. lemon juice
- 1 T. sugar
- Freshly cracked black pepper
- 1/4 c. finely chopped red onion
- 1/4 c. raisins
- 1/4 c. dried cranberries
- 1/4 c. toasted sliced almonds

Steam the broccoli according to the package directions. Add the thyme, garlic and zest to a large bowl and brush or rub the ingredients against the bottom and sides of the bowl. Add the steamed broccoli and toss. Refrigerate until chilled.

In a med. bowl, add the mayonnaise, sriracha, lemon juice, sugar and some black pepper. Whisk until the sugar dissolves. Add the red onions, raisins and cranberries. Stir to combine.

Discard the thyme from the broccoli. Add the dressing and gently fold until the broccoli is evenly coated.

Serve chilled or at room temperature sprinkled with the almonds.

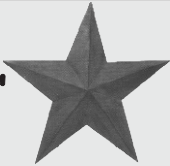

Country Register Recipe

Chicken Pot Pie Soup

6 T. butter
1 med. yellow onion, chopped
2 med. carrots, thinly sliced
2 celery sticks, finely chopped
8 oz mushrooms, sliced
3 garlic cloves, minced
1/3 c. flour
6 c. chicken stock
3-4 tsp. salt
1/2 tsp. black pepper
1# potatoes, sliced into 1/4" thick pieces
5 c. cooked chicken, shredded
1 c. frozen peas
1 c. corn, frozen or canned
1/2 c. whipping cream
1/4 c. parsley, finely chopped, plus more for garnish

Heat a soup pot over med/high heat and melt in 6 T. butter. Add onion, celery, and carrots and sauté 5-7 min, stirring occasionally, until softened and lightly golden. Add sliced mushrooms and garlic. Sauté for another 5 min, stirring occasionally until softened. Add 1/3 c. flour and stir constantly for 1 min. until golden.

Add 6 c. chicken stock, sliced potatoes, 3-1/2 tsp. salt (or to taste), and 1/2 tsp. black pepper. Bring to a boil then reduce heat to a simmer, partially cover and cook 12-15 min. or just until potatoes are tender.

Add shredded chicken, frozen peas, and frozen corn, heavy whipping cream and parsley. Bring back to a simmer and continue to cook for another 5 min. or until peas and corn are tender. Season to taste with salt and pepper and remove from heat. Serve hot.
